



1. Camp in the Designed Area

- Farm operations must continue before & after Harvest.
- If you don't work for us, you can't stay in the Camp (unless you've made prior arrangements).
 - Camp Facilities are not for guests. Friends are welcome to visit but not to stay over.
- Campfires are NOT allowed due to annual Municipal RDOS Fire Restrictions.



2. Be Nice to Each Other

- **Lights Out after 10 pm** - The camp is a Work Camp. Let your friends SLEEP!!!
- Clearly mark your food / beverages. Don't eat or drink other people's stuff.
 - **Warning:** Our dogs: "BUDDY" & "COPPER" will steal whatever they can get. Keep your food & possessions safe inside your closed tent. Don't reward them for bad behaviour.
- **DO NOT LEAVE VALUABLE ITEMS UNATTENDED !!!** (Laptops, Tablets, Phones, etc)
- Try to not spread germs. Wash your hands frequently. Wear appropriate PPE as required.
 - If you're sick, please let us know immediately and we'll do what we can to help you get better.



3. NO Hard Drugs of any type Allowed

- No Drinking or Pot Smoking before or during your work day including lunch time.



4. Work Hard, Work Smart, Work Safe

- **Both Pickers & Sorters may be asked to do the other's job as required.**
- **Pickers:**
 - Get an early start. It's best to pick when it's cool. 5^{am} is perfect.
 - Start at the top before the heat of the day really kicks-in.
 - No Night Picking. Nights are for sleeping.
 - Pick your tree completely. Every cherry must be picked (Spic & Span)
 - If your tree is not picked clean, you will be asked to finish it. Don't leave cherries on the trees!
 - Undesirable cherries (rotten or excessively small) are to be thrown on the ground (not into the bucket)
 - Please leave the Spurs and Leaves on the Tree. **Don't hurt the Tree** ... It never did anything to you!
- **Sorters:**
 - You start at 6:30 (unless otherwise advised)
 - Why? You need cherries to do your job, so you'll have to wait for the Pickers or start by picking yourself until sorting can start. We work till what we picked is packed. Your work-day may be long.



5. KEEP the Camp & Orchard CLEAN

- Make your Mother Proud! Better yet, Make Farmer Joe Proud!!!
- Put your Garbage & Re-Cycling in the appropriate bins. Separate Cans, Bottles, Cardboard properly.
 - Keep the bins in the garbage enclosure. Farmer Joe will pick-up & put out on the road.
- Dogs Are Allowed. Please clean-up after them. No one likes stepping in Doggy Do-Do.
- Keep the Porto-Potty tidy. If you're about to run out of Supplies, let someone know.
- Wash your Hands and your stuff frequently
 - Water is safe for drinking & washing anywhere on the Orchard.
 - Plastic Buckets can be used for washing your cloths or dirty dishes
 - **DO NOT USE PICKING BUCKETS for anything other than PICKING**
